World Peace Man and Canada's #1 Guinness World record Holder Final day Celebration at Queens Park.

Final day here I come – Suresh Joachim is on his final stretch that will commence on September 22nd, 2018 at 4:30 pm in Queens Park, Toronto. In the hope to hear people applauding and cheering him to cross that finish line and new World Record

Suresh will run his last marathon with the World Peace Torch at 12:30 pm on September 22nd in front of Mississauga City Centre - Ontario Canada. He will finish at Queens Park - 111 Wellesley Street West Toronto Ontario M7A 1A2 Canada and hand over the peace torch to the Canadian leaders at 4:30 pm with a grand celebration on stage.

The World Peace Man and Multiple Guinness World Record holder Suresh Joachim lit up the World Peace Torch in Bethlehem. Suresh began his first marathon in Jerusalem on December 25th, 2017. He ran in **6 continents, 72 countries and 126 cities covering over 3,567 kilometers in 271 days creating the new world record to declare August 1st as No Poverty No Disease No War Day (World ceasefire Day)**

During his marathon he was able to meet Canadian representatives in Hong Kong, Serbia, India and other countries. I passed the peace torch to many leaders including Nobel Peace Director, Mayor of Oslo and Ireland, Ministers, Premiers, Police, Army, Actors, Business Leaders and the people who hope one day for world peace.

During my marathon, I have collected people's messages for world peace in more than 50 languages. I have traveled on 90 airplanes, 60 buses, 28 trains and taxis.

About Suresh Joachim - Suresh Joachim is a Canadian of great resolve. In his dictionary, you will not find the word "quit" or any derivative thereof. He has travelled the world while running, moon-walking, walking, crawling, breakdancing, ballroom dancing, rocking, and performing many other tasks noted in this great big book of "The Guinness World Records". He is featured in 2019 Guinness world record again on page 117.

He pushes himself past the brink of exhaustion and pain that defeats most individuals to capture his dream of breaking a world record and help those in need while doing it. Suresh is Canada's #1 Guinness World Record Holder and second in the world. Suresh says we need "No Poverty No Disease No War Day" for all the people in the world in this new era. The world peace marathon gave him a big vote of confidence with all the leaders around the world.
